Phoenix Programs, Inc. provides a continuum of evidence-based treatment services for Medicaid recipients including:

Individual Counseling

One on one time with a certified counselor to discover the participant's motivation to change and set treatment goals focusing on recovery.

Group Counseling

A setting in which a small group supports and helps one another learn to manage a life free of alcohol or other drugs. Participants share experiences, encouragement and hope.

Family Therapy

Appointments with a qualified counselor to help families repair damage substance use has caused.

Group Education

Classroom setting to learn about the effects of alcohol and drug use on the brain and body and explore life skills topics to strengthen recovery.

Family Conference

A session with a qualified counselor which involves the participant and family members working together to create treatment goals and build additional family support.

Vocational Support

Assistance with job search ability as well support in resume development and interview skills aimed at securing meaningful employment.

Trauma Counseling

Sessions with a qualified counselor to develop coping skills; to sustain recovery as it relates to significant painful past events including physical, sexual, emotional abuse, neglect, violence or loss.

Women's Groups

Small group therapy sessions with other women and a trained counselor. Women only groups are beneficial to encourage women to move forward with recovery in a comfortable setting.
