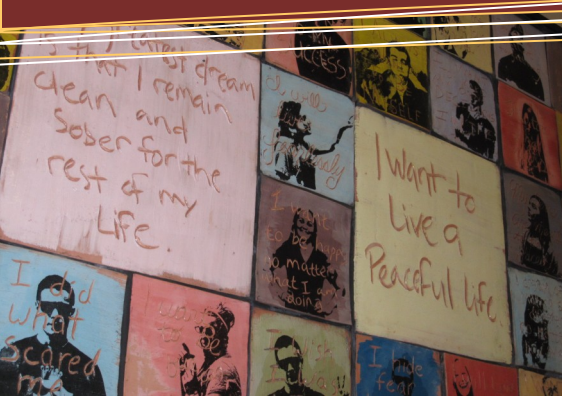

Phoenix Programs, Inc. offers SATOP for people who have been arrested in Missouri for drug and/or alcohol related driving offenses

## What do I do if I have an alcohol or drug related traffic offense?

Missouri law requires all persons who have an alcohol or drug related traffic offense to complete an assessment screening at an Offender Management Unit (OMU). The result of this evaluation determines the appropriate level of placement for each consumer.

**Cost:** \$375.00\*

## What SATOP Services does Phoenix Programs offer?

### **Offender Education Program (10 hours)**

**Cost: \$130.00\***

Last two Tuesdays of the Month 11:30 AM - 5:00 PM.

### **Clinical Intervention Program (50 hours)**

**Cost: Based on income**

Mondays and Wednesdays 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM

Includes additional individual counseling appointments (times will vary).

## What if I am recommended for more intensive treatment?

If you are required to have more intensive substance abuse treatment, Phoenix Programs can provide ANY level of treatment recommended.
